

THE GREATER NEW HAVEN WATER POLLUTION CONTROL AUTHORITY
REVISED FEE SCHEDULE OF CONNECTION CHARGES
Effective July 1, 2008

The Authority's 2006 Connection Fee Study established an Equivalent Residential Unit (ERU) rate for a standard 5/8" water meter size based on flow data provide by the American Water Works Association Manual of Water Supply Practices. The Authority's current ERU rate is \$1,860.

Fees shall be based on the building's water meter size in accordance with the following schedule:

For Residential Developments, the Connection Permit Fee shall be calculated as the higher of the Water Meter Size Connection Permit Fee or the charge of \$ 1,860 (current ERU rate) per Residential Unit times the number of Residential Units¹, which ever is larger.

¹Residential Unit: A "residential unit" is any building or portion thereof which contains one or more habitable rooms that are occupied by, or designed or intended to be occupied by, one person or by a family or group of housemates living together as a single housekeeping unit that includes facilities for living, sleeping and facilities for cooking, eating, and sanitation.

For water meter sizes greater than 4 inches and/or flow rates greater than 5,000 gallons per day in a non-residential application, the Connection Permit Fee shall be established based on the specifics of the connection.

Where applicable, Disconnection Permit Fees shall be credited toward a new Connection Permit Fee at the time of application for the connection permit.

The installation of grease traps and oil/sand separators independent of any other site work shall be charged a standard repair fee of \$385.

All applications to Authority constituent municipalities Building Departments shall be subject to the Authority's Fees regardless of the extent of replacement, renovation or addition.

Such Fees are to be paid by check at time of issuance of the Permit.
