Holbrook, to negotiate, execute and deliver an agreement with DBS Energy, Inc. for services relating to the installation of exterior LED lighting at 345 East Shore Parkway, New Haven, CT, for an amount not to exceed \$60,127 less a UI Utility incentive of \$22,060 for a net project cost of \$38,067.

Director Fimiani made the following motion:

RESOLVED: That the agreement with DBS Energy, Inc. for services relating to the installation of exterior LED lighting at 345 East Shore Parkway, New Haven, CT, for an amount not to exceed \$60,127 less a UI Utility incentive of \$22,060 for a net project cost of \$38,067, as further described in the Exhibit to Agenda Item #4, is hereby approved, and the Executive Director, Sidney J.
