PROJECT: SANITARY SEWER COLLECTION SYSTEM ON-CALL REPAIRS

Sealed proposals will be received at the Office of the Director of Finance and Administration of the Greater New Haven Water Pollution Control Authority (Authority) located at 260 East Street, New Haven, Connecticut 06511 for **PROJECT: SANITARY SEWER COLLECTION SYSTEM ON-CALL REPAIRS (SSR 2022-02)** until **10:00 AM on Thursday, May 26, 2022.**

Contract to be awarded is defined as providing on-call repair services of the sanitary sewer system in the Greater New Haven Water Pollution Control Authority service area.

The purpose of this Request for Proposal (RFP) is to identify a short list of Contractors to provide on-call sewer repair services for the next two years. The Authority is seeking contractors who could be available on a regular basis to provide on-call services (both routine and emergency). Interested firms are invited to submit their responses in conformance with the criteria outlined in the RFP.

The Request for Proposal, Contract for Construction Services, and Standard Specifications may be examined at the Office of the Construction Administrator at the above address. Anyone submitting a bid for this project must have in their possession a copy of THE GREATER NEW HAVEN WATER POLLUTION CONTROL AUTHORITY STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS dated September 2017. The document can be obtained upon payment of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00). The RFP can be obtained upon payment of a nonrefundable fee of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00).

A pre-submittal video conference will be held on Thursday, May 19, 2022 at 10:00 AM to be hosted by the Greater New Haven Water Pollution Control Authority – Engineering Department. All registered Bidders will receive an email in advance with additional pre-bid meeting instructions. At this meeting Authority’s staff will discuss the scope of work, general contract issues and respond to questions from attendees.

The successful Contractor(s) will be required to furnish a performance bond and a labor and materials payment bond in the form as attached to the RFP for \$50,000.00. A certified check can not be substituted for either bond. The Authority reserves the right to reject any or all proposals, as it may deem to be in its best interests.
