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### PROJECT SSR 2022-05: FARM RIVER INTERCEPTOR TWIN PIPES

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PROJECT AREA: EAST HAVEN – SALTONSTALL PARKWAY – TORELLO TIRE

#### PROJECT OVERVIEW

This Project will rehabilitate the portion of the Farm River Trunk Sewer which includes twin pipes that pass through the Torello Tire Parking Lot at 187 Saltonstall Parkway. The pipes will be rehabilitated using a Cured in Place Pipe (CIPP) lining technology. CIPP lining is a proven trenchless rehabilitation process that involves installing a resin-saturated felt tube into an existing sewer pipe, that is inflated and hardened to create a new plastic pipe within the old pipe. During the process, a steam cloud coming from a vent stack at a manhole may be visible and occasionally there may be a “glue like” odor (styrene) during the curing process that will dissipate quickly when the process is complete. Prior to lining, crews need to clean the pipe using high pressure water hoses and video cameras to inspect the pipe condition. Crews will also need to set up a sewer bypass system. As such, business and residents may see activities related to the sewer relining for several weeks leading up to the actual lining.

#### BENEFITS

- Rehabilitates aging infrastructure.
- Allows for increased sewer flow capacity.
- Further protects the areas tributary to the Farm River.

#### IMPACTS

- Some traffic impacts and night work is expected.
- Notices will be handed to nearby residents providing additional information/guidance on how to prevent potential sewer and styrene odors from potentially back drafting into homes.

#### TIMING AND COORDINATION

**Construction Start:** Spring 2023

**Duration:** The entire project is expected to take approximately 2 months.

**Schedule:** Due to dynamics of construction schedule, weather and other factors, dates and times are subject to change.
