RESPONSE

QUESTION

Regarding the insurance requirements for “Electronic Data Processing”, can you please provide clarification on intent? Our policies have not typically called this type of requirement out specifically and we are curious as to whether the intent was for cyber liability, which we have encountered, and our policy covers. Any additional insight would be helpful in our understanding of the requirements.

RESPONSE

Electronic Data Processing (EDP) insurance is a specialized form of property insurance that covers computer hardware, software, and data-related assets from damage, loss, or corruption. The Authority requires this coverage from its engineering consultants to ensure continuity of service in the event of a data-related incident. This requirement is not intended to address cyber liability exposures such as hacking or data breaches, but rather to protect the Authority’s interests if critical project data or work products are lost or damaged. EDP insurance ensures the consultant has the resources to restore data, recover systems, and reperform any necessary work—without seeking additional compensation from the Authority. This helps prevent project delays and limits financial exposure due to technology-related disruptions in service delivery.
